

20/20 SeedSense PC Demo and Setup Tool

The SeedSense PC Demo and Setup Tool is provided by Precision Planting. It is designed to give you the ability to enter your planter information, GPS measurements, client/farm/field hierarchy, crops, hybrids/varieties, AirForce settings, and RowFlow settings on your home or office computer and transfer that information to the 20/20 SeedSense with a USB drive.

System Requirements

The SeedSense PC Demo and Setup Tool will function with the Windows XP, Windows Vista, and Windows 7 Operating Systems.

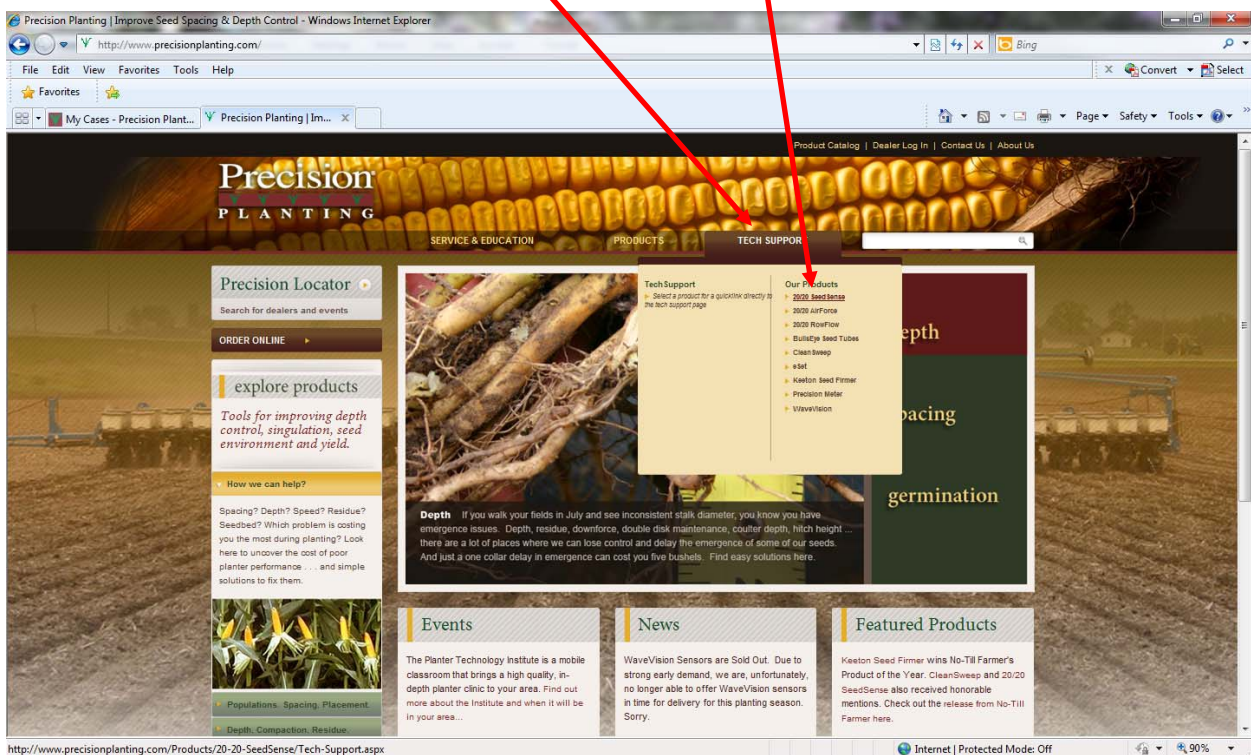

Downloading and Installation

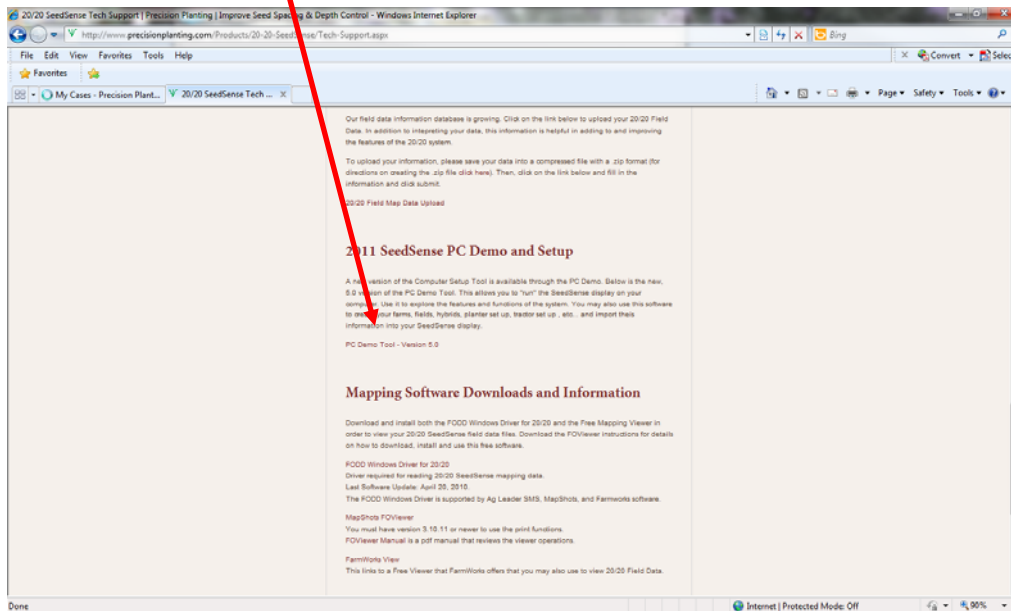
These instructions use the Windows 7 Operating System. Installation on other supported versions of windows will be similar.

To download and install the Setup Tool:

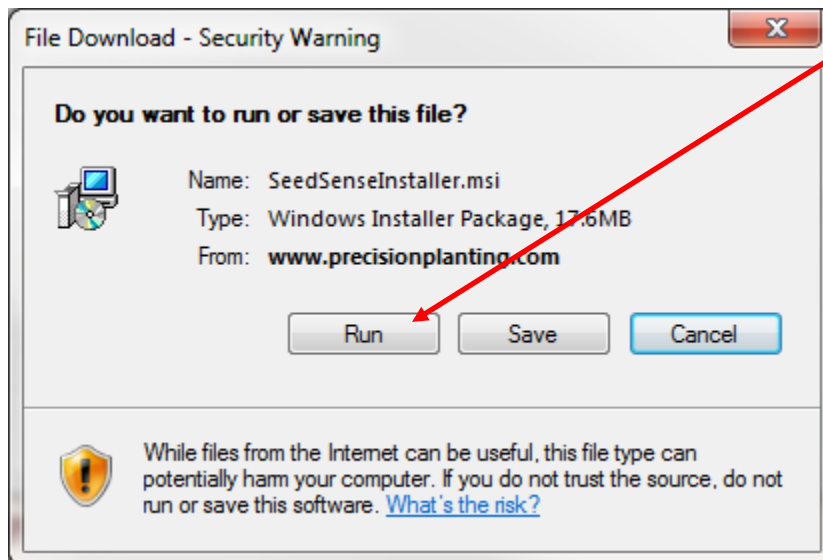
1. Go to the following website: <http://www.precisionplanting.com>
2. Click on “Technical Support” and then on “20/20 SeedSense” as shown below.



3. Now click on “PC Demo Tool – Version 5.0”

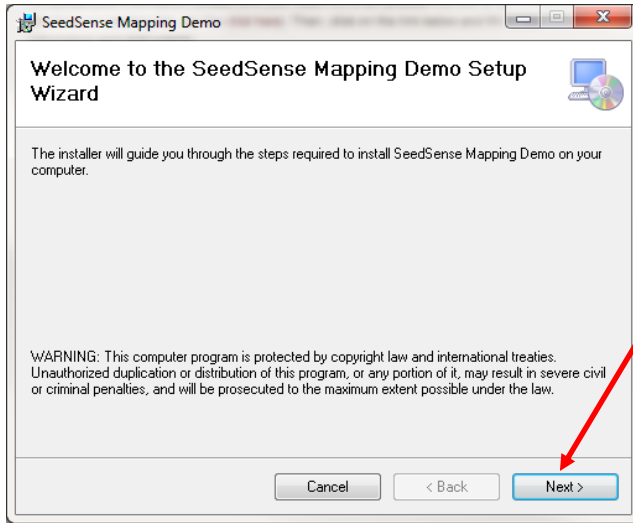


4. When you click on the link, a dialog box will appear. Click “Run”.

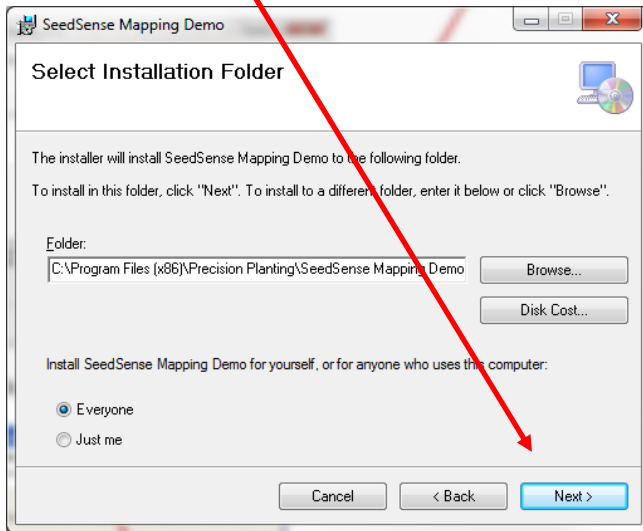


Note: You may receive an “Unknown Publisher” warning. If so, press “Run” and installation will continue.

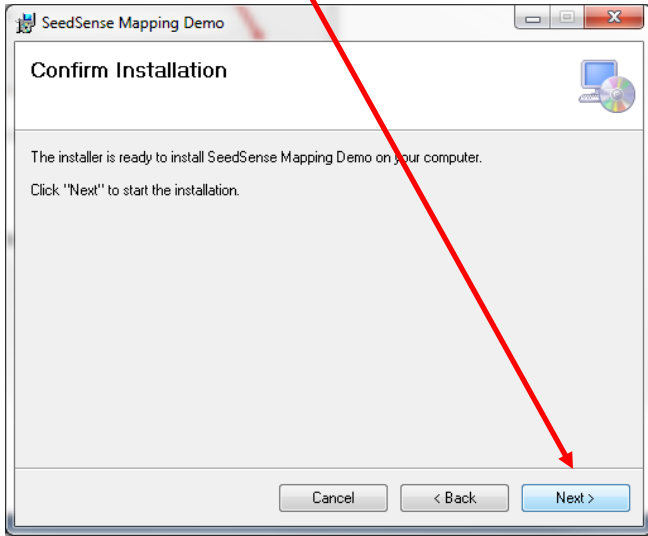
5. Now, the Setup Wizard will appear as below. Click "Next".



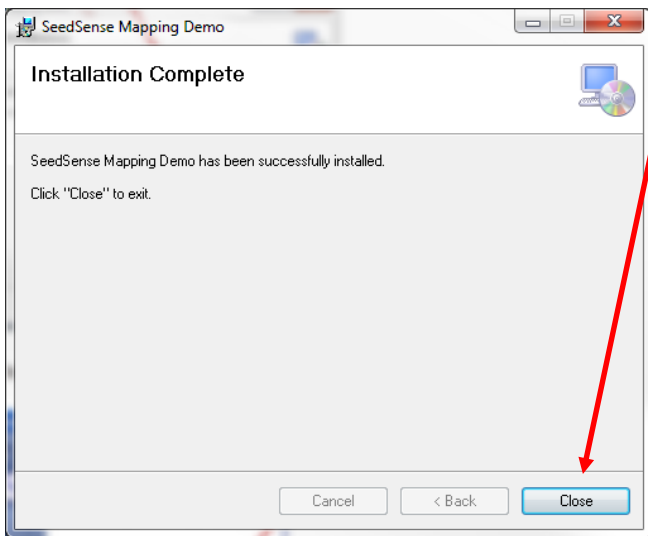
6. Click "Next" again to accept the default folder location.



7. Now click "Next" to install the software.



8. The installation is now complete. Click "Close".



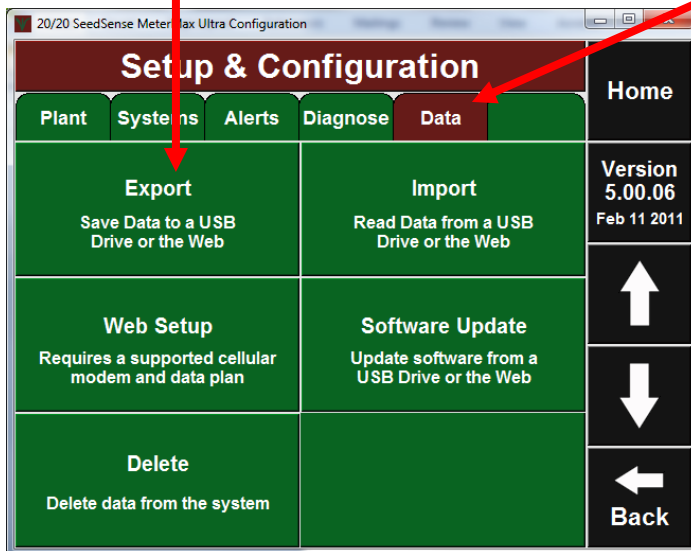
Using the Setup Tool

The SeedSense Setup Tool is used to configure your SeedSense display while at your home or office computer. You may then save the configuration to a USB drive to load into your 20/20 monitor.

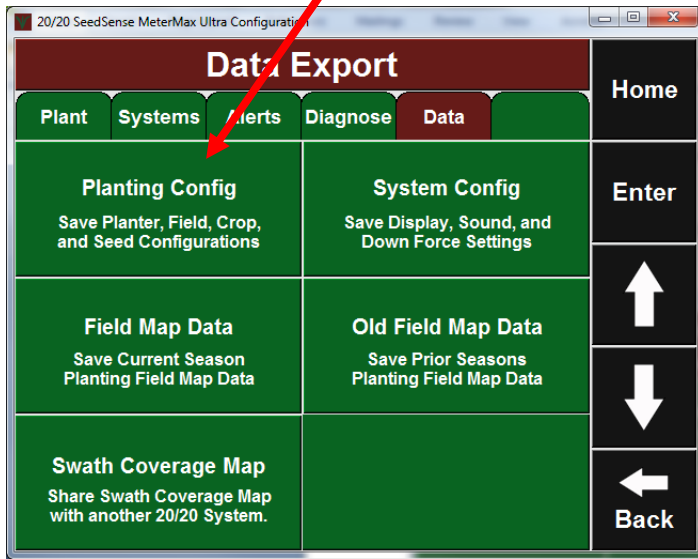
The setup tool is a PC-based version of the SeedSense software. The software screens in the Setup Tool are identical to those in the actual display. To setup your SeedSense using the Setup tool, follow the instructions for configuring your planter in the 2011 SeedSense Operator's Manual (available on the SeedSense Tech Support page of the Precision Planting website).

Once you have entered all of your configurations in the Setup Tool, you are ready to export your configuration.

- 1) On the Setup Tool home page, press SETUP, then the DATA tab, and then EXPORT.



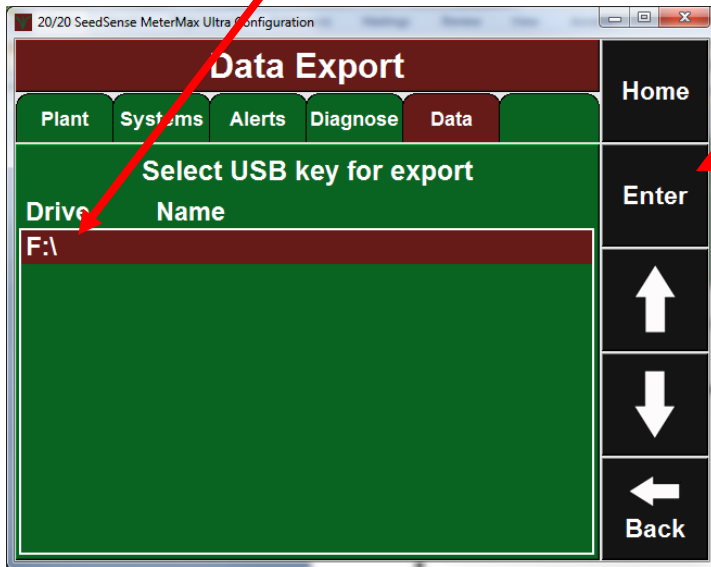
2) Next, press PLANTING CONFIG.



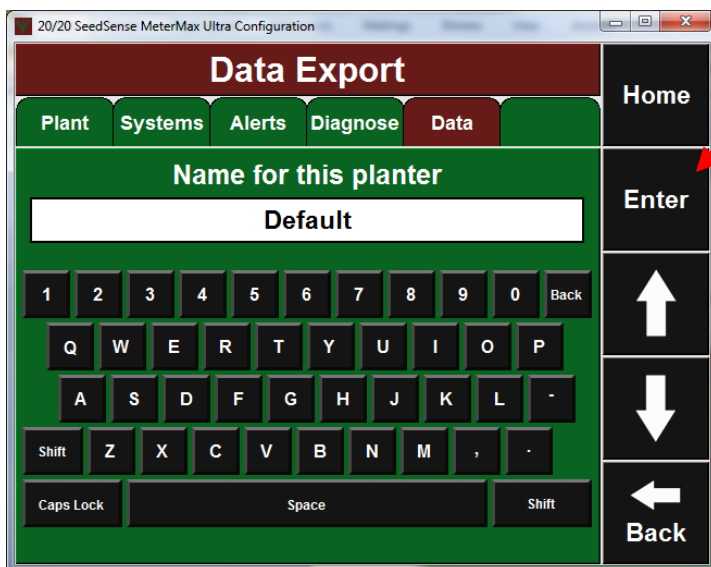
3) Insert your USB drive when prompted. If your USB drive is already in the computer, hit "Browse".



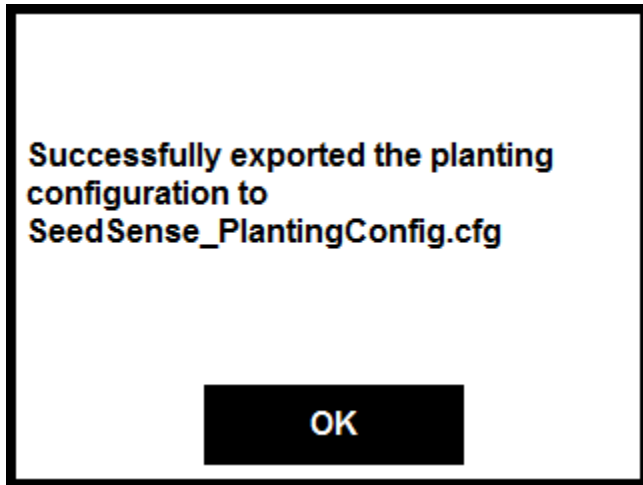
4) Select the drive to which you will save the configuration file and press ENTER.



5) Now, name the configuration file. Use a name that will uniquely identify the planter and tractor to which the file will apply. Press ENTER.

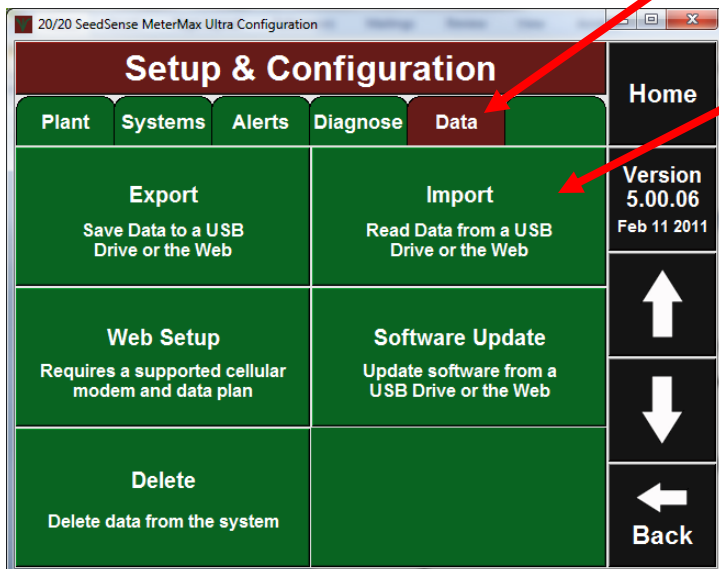


6) The following message indicates a successful export:

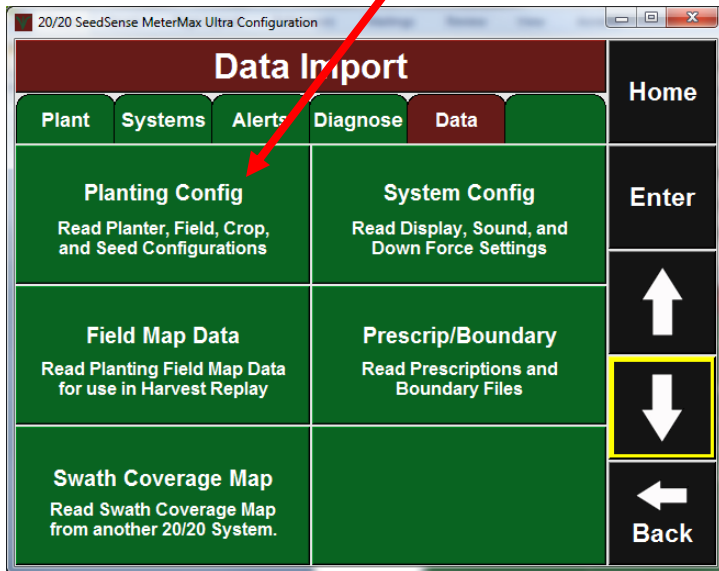


7) Now remove your USB drive from the computer and insert it into one of the USB ports on the SeedSense display.

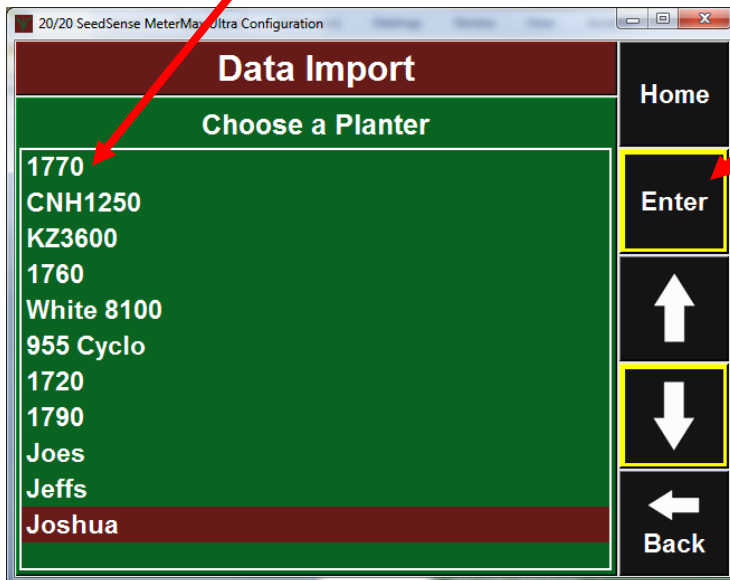
8) On the display, press SETUP, then the DATA tab, and then IMPORT.



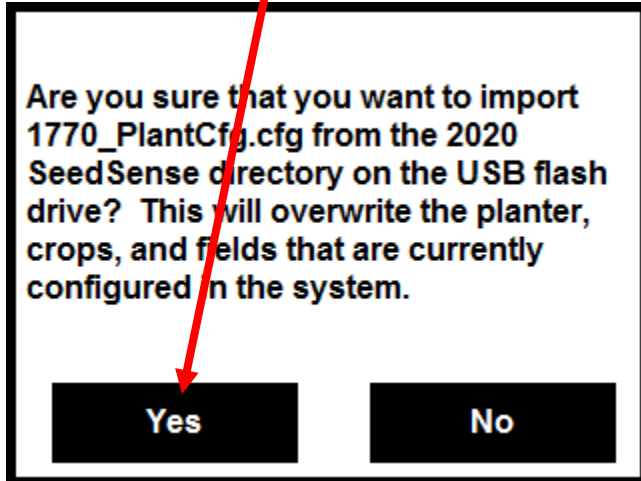
9) Now press PLANTING CONFIG.



10) Select your configuration file from the list of configuration files that you have created. If you only have one planter, it is likely that you will only have one configuration file. Once you have selected the file, press ENTER.



11) Note that the configuration file will overwrite the existing configuration file. Make sure that all available information has been included in the file being imported and press YES.



12) The following message indicates a successful import. Press OK.
